In addition to the normal business conducted at our Annual General Meeting, you will note that we have also called an Extraordinary General Meeting. This is because the Directors are proposing two Special Resolutions:

- 1. the first to broaden the 'Objects' of QCCC; and,
- 2. the second to replace our Articles of Association with new Articles.

In early August, 2021 QCCC received consent from OSCR, the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator, to amend the purposes and objects of our organisation.

It is recommended by your Board that Members vote in favour of these two special resolutions as it will enable us to broaden the services we offer and formalise new ways of working as we adapt to the ongoing challenges presented by Coronavirus. Our existing Articles of Association have now been merged with the recommended updated Articles produced by The Scottish Council for Voluntary Organisations (SCVO) and a new governing document created. This will enable us to hold AGM and General Meetings in future years offering Members an online Audio/Visual technological attendance option. You may note we have taken the opportunity also to simplify and modernise the wording within our various governing clauses.
