#### WHO ARE WE?

Queensferry Care was established in 1993 as a registered charity, dedicated to providing quality support services to older people and their carers within the communities of rural North-West Edinburgh.

Our mission is to enhance the quality of life of those we support and to enable them to maintain an active, independent lifestyle.



#### WHAT WE DO

**Day Care:** is registered with the Care Inspectorate and provides care and support to older people. This includes people who are socially isolated, those with reduced mobility, long-term health conditions or a diagnosis of dementia. Day Care runs Monday to Friday at The Haven.

**Befriending Service:** provides trained volunteers to visit older people living at home, to offer companionship, a friendly ear and contact with the wider community.

**Almond Supper Club:** is registered with the Care Inspectorate. This group meets on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month. The focus is for people with a diagnosis of dementia and their carer to enjoy a meal together in a relaxed and supported environment.

**Information Café, Ratho and Memory Café, South Queensferry:** provides a friendly drop in service for anyone who may need support, information or advice about carer support, dementia or older people's services.



**The Volunteer Hub:** supports organisations and groups who provide volunteering opportunities and social activities that are inclusive of older people.

**Carer Support:** provides information and signposting to carers within the communities we support. VOCAL's Carer Support Worker is based at The Haven Monday and Tuesday.

**Information and Advice:** We are a community resource for older people and carers who wish to access general information and contact details particular to their situation.
